- Demonstrated excellence (or potential for excellence) in college teaching, including instructional design and dynamic classroom management, and continual assessment of student learning.
- Demonstrated scholarly ability (or potential for scholarship) to develop and communicate insight into topics related to business.
- Mature interpersonal, collaborative, and oral and written communication skills that indicate the ability to work effectively with students, faculty and staff, community members, and other professionals.
- Desire to further the mission of Dordt University through collaborative student recruitment and retention efforts, student advising, campus and community service, and ongoing professional and program development.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Teach introductory and advanced undergraduate courses and possibly online courses in Business, Accounting, or Economics subject areas.
- Advise students in Business Administration/Accounting/Economics.
- Participate as a full team member in department and college administrative tasks (including curriculum development and review, assessment, developing new initiatives, student recruiting and advising, and committee assignments).
