



## **JOB DESCRIPTION**

**DEPARTMENT:** Music

**POSITION TYPE:** Full-Time Faculty

**PURPOSE OF POSITION:** A full-time faculty position to serve as a one year leave replacement and caretaker for a thriving choral music program.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Conduct four of Dordt's five choirs (which includes a brief Midwest tour)
- Recruit new singers and award vocal music scholarships to deserving high school seniors who apply
- Observe and evaluate music education students during their student-teaching experience
- Supervise department student employees
- Communicate with voice faculty and assist in end of semester voice lesson evaluations
- Participate as a full team member in department and university administrative tasks
- Participate in university-wide/departmental service.
- Other duties as assigned.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Personal commitment to a Reformed-Biblical perspective and the ability to articulate how this Christian perspective shapes the teaching and practice of music.
- Personal endorsement of *The Educational Task of Dordt University* and commitment to the curricular design set forth in *The Educational Framework of Dordt University*.
- A master's degree in Music is required.
- Mature interpersonal, collaborative, and oral and written communication skills that indicate the ability to work effectively with students, faculty and staff, community members, and other professionals.
